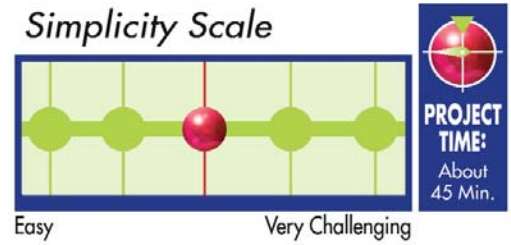




# Project #195 & 196 Heritage StoryTeller® Photo Book:

**Preserve and share your family's heritage photos with a beautiful hard-bound photo book.**

If you are fortunate enough to have inherited your family's heritage photos, you can now capture those memories in a beautiful, hard-bound coffee-table book! Scan and restore the photos to their original condition using an Epson scanner and save to your computer or a disc. Simply import the photos, add your text, print, and assemble for a memento that will be treasured for generations.

### Materials Suggested:

**(Not all are required) For printing:** A 5" x 7" or 8" x 10" Epson StoryTeller® Photo Book Creator and an Epson Stylus Photo Printer.

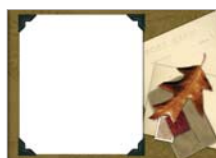

**Step 1:** Choose your photo book size, either 5" x 7" or 8" x 10", to make your StoryTeller book. Note that you can choose the 8" x 10" size in either a 10- or 20- page option.

**Step 2:** Click on the selected StoryTeller page templates you wish to include in your StoryTeller book. There are a total of 12 color and design-coordinated pages provided in each size, as well as a cover and a back cover template. Open the downloaded page templates in either Adobe Photoshop or Photoshop Elements – they will be in .png format. (You can choose to print them or position them within your book in any order you please.) For printing 5" x 7" books, choose the files named #195; for printing 8" x 10" books, choose files named #196. Then choose the page design by the title shown below each design preview.

**Step 3:** Copy your photos onto a new layer behind the StoryTeller template layer. Crop and/or resize to fit in the open window of the template.

**Step 4:** Add your journaling, captions and dates using the text tool on a new layer above the StoryTeller template layer.

**Step 5:** Your personalizing is complete! Print your StoryTeller pages. Remember to choose the correct paper size and paper type setting (Premium Glossy Photo Paper) in your printer driver.

**Step 6:** Assemble the completed StoryTeller pages following the instructions provided in the kit. For the cover, simply print a 5" x 7" or 8" x 10" cover using the template provided in this project and paste onto the front of your book (using acid-free adhesive).

**Step 7:** You can stop there, or you may want to add embellishments to some or all of your pages, as you wish.
